Challenge 2 **Who is St Joan of Arc?**

TASK:

Write a one-page profile or fact file all about our school saint, Saint Joan of Arc.

We would like it to include:

- Background information (e.g. date of birth, date of death, family etc).
- Where did she live? (what was the country like at the time?)
- A picture or drawing of Saint Joan.
- Facts about her legacy (what was her biggest achievement? How was she captured? Why did she stand trial?)
- A description of why you think Saint Joan represents our school.
