

Uniform and Equipment List

School Uniform –ESSENTIAL ITEMS

BOYS	
Shirt	Plain white long sleeved (worn with tie) Plain white short sleeved in summer term only (worn with tie)
School Tie	Tie must be worn with top of the tie touching the top of the belt line
Trousers	Plain black
School Blazer	Maroon with embroidered badge
Shoes	Plain black or dark brown leather in a style suitable for school (no plimsolls, trainers, boots or canvas shoes)
Socks	Plain dark grey/black

GIRLS	
Blouse	Plain white with revere collar – long or short sleeved (worn without tie)
Kilt*and/or Trousers*	Tartan kilt - knee length or just below Black trousers with school initials (SJA) – may be worn all year round – only available from Beat School Uniform.
School Blazer*	Maroon with embroidered badge
Shoes	Plain black or dark brown leather in a style suitable for school (no plimsolls, trainers, platforms, boots or canvas shoes)
Socks	Plain white or plain black
Tights	Plain natural or plain black

School Uniform –OPTIONAL ITEMS

BOTH	
Jumper*	Maroon V-neck with school logo
Scarves	Plain black or plain navy
Outdoor clothing	Coats or jackets in plain dark colours. Leather jackets, denim jackets or jackets with logos are not allowed
Outdoor footwear	Black boots in a style suitable for school may be worn to school during bad weather but must be changed and shoes (not trainers) worn during the school day

Pencil case	Ruler, pen, pencils, coloured pencils, gluestick, scissors, pencil sharpener, eraser
Maths instruments	30 cm & 15 cm rulers, set square, protractor, pair of compasses

Atlas	Philips Modern School Atlas
Bible	Good News translation (to remain at home for homework)
Dictionary	Oxford English Dictionary for Schools recommended
French or Italian Dictionary	Oxford Learners French Dictionary or Oxford Study Italian Dictionary recommended
Art & Design materials	Art Homework Materials pack.
A5 Notebook	Preferably hardbacked – to be used as a 'link book' to relay messages between the school and parents.

PLEASE NOTE

- Parents are asked to ensure that pupils wear correct uniform at all times. If for any reason a pupil is unable to wear correct uniform, they must have a note which is handed to their form tutor during morning registration.
- Cult hairstyles are not allowed – shaved to less than a Number 2 is not permitted. Long hair **must** be tied back with a plain hairband and no styling products are allowed. Jewellery is not allowed. Pupils with pierced ears are permitted to wear **one** pair of plain studs in the ear lobe. No other body piercing is allowed. **Valuable** watches may **not** be worn. Make-up and nail varnish are not allowed.
- Outdoor clothing must not be worn indoors. The **only** garment to be worn over a jumper indoors is a blazer (or apron where appropriate). , **iPods, computer games, chewing gum, toxic forms of liquid correction fluid, aerosols, cigarettes, lighters, matches and any other dangerous items or items of value** are **not** allowed in school.
- All uniform and personal property should be marked with nametapes or other permanent marking.
- Money and valuables should be safeguarded at all times. Large amounts of money should **not** be brought to school.
